Description

The Charts collection contains all charts in the specified worksheet. Chart sheets are not included in this collection. To return a `Charts` collection, use [Worksheet.Charts](#).

Properties

Name	Description
Count	Returns the number of charts in the worksheet.

Indexers

Name	Description
Item(Int32)	Returns the chart at the specified 0-based position in the Charts collection.
Item(String)	Returns the chart with the specified name in the Charts collection.

Methods

Name	Description
AddChart(Chart, Anchor)	Creates a copy of the specified chart and adds it to the current worksheet. This method allows you to add a chart from an external workbook to the worksheet, or to duplicate a chart within a single workbook. The properties and settings on the original chart will be preserved
CreateChart(ChartType, Anchor)	Creates a new, blank chart of the specified type.
GetEnumerator()	Returns an <code>IEnumerator</code> for the Charts in a Worksheet
Remove(Chart)	Permanently removes the specified chart from the worksheet.
Remove(Int32)	Permanently removes the chart at the specified position from the worksheet.
