Description

Creates a new [FunctionValue](#) object setting the [Value](#) property to the [Range](#) passed in to the constructor and setting the [Type](#) property to [FunctionValueType.RANGE](#).

C#

public FunctionValue(Range range)
```

vb.net

```
Public Sub New FunctionValue(range As Range)
```

Examples

C#

```
ExcelApplication xla = new ExcelApplication();
Workbook wb = xla.Create();

wb.Worksheets.CreateWorksheet("Sheet2");

Range rng = wb.CreateRange("=Sheet1!A1:A3, Sheet2!A2:C5");

FunctionValue myValue = new FunctionValue(rng);
```

vb.net

```
Dim xla As New ExcelApplication()
Dim wb As Workbook = xla.Create()

wb.Worksheets.CreateWorksheet("Sheet2")

Dim rng As Range = wb.CreateRange("=Sheet1!A1:A3, Sheet2!A2:C5")

Dim myValue As New FunctionValue(rng)
