• MS Query

MS Query is part of Microsoft Office, but may not be installed by default. To install MS Query:

- 1. Have your Office Installation CD ready.
- 2. Open Microsoft Excel.
- 3. Open the **Data** menu.
- 4. Select **Import External Data > New Database Query**. You will be prompted to install MS Query.



The version of the OfficeWriter Designer should be the same version, or earlier, than the version of OfficeWriter on the server. Generally we recommend using the same version number for OfficeWriter for Reporting Services on the server and client.
