Description

Creates a [DataValidation](#) object which can be set on a [Range](#), [Area](#), or [Cell](#).

C#

```
public DataValidation CreateDataValidation(ValidationType allowedType, ComparisonType comparison, System.String minValue, System.String maxValue)
```

vb.net

```
Public Function CreateDataValidation(ByVal allowedType As ValidationType, ByVal comparison As ComparisonType, ByVal minValue As String, ByVal maxValue As String) As DataValidation
```

Parameters

allowedType

The data type allowed in the cell.

comparison

The comparison used to validate the cell's value.

minValue

A formula representing the cell's maximum value.

maxValue

A formula representing the cell's minimum value.

Returns

A [DataValidation](#) object.

Examples

```
DataValidation dataValidation =  
    wb.createDataValidation(  
        DataValidation.ValidationType.WholeNumber,  
        DataValidation.ComparisonType.Between, "=1", "=100");
```

vb.net

```
Dim dataValidation As DataValidation = _  
    wb.createDataValidation( _  
        DataValidation.ValidationType.WholeNumber, _  
        DataValidation.ComparisonType.Between, "=1", "=100")
```
