

# TableCell.GetBorder(Border.Location)

## Description

Returns a [Border](#) object that lets you manipulate the border this table cell at a particular location.

**C#**

```
public Border GetBorder(Location location)
```

**vb.net**

```
Public Function GetBorder(ByVal location As Location) As Border
```

## Parameters

### *location*

A [Location](#) object that represents the location of the Border to return.

## Returns

A [Border](#) object that represents the border for this table cell at a particular location.

## Remarks

Allowed locations are Top, Left, Bottom, and Right. They refer to the border for those sides of the table cell.

Word equivalent: Format menu > Borders and Shading... > Borders tab

## Examples

**C#**

```
//--- Set the Left Border color to blue  
cell.GetBorder(Border.Location.Left).Color = Color.Blue;
```

**vb.net**

```
'--- Set the Left Border color to blue  
cell.GetBorder(Border.Location.Left).Color = Color.Blue
```
