

AbsolutePositioning.Width

Description

Sets or returns an `int` that represents the absolute width in twips. One twip = (1/20 pt) or (1/1440 in)

C#

```
public int Width{ get; set; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Property Width() As Integer
```

Remarks

The width of Paragraph must be between 0.01" (15 twips) and 22" (31680 twips). The width of a table must be between 0" (0 twips) and 22" (31680 twips). Values beyond these will be automatically adjusted.

Examples

C#

```
//--- Get Width  
int width = oAbsolutePositioning.Width;  
  
//--- Set Width to 3 inches  
oAbsolutePositioning.Width = 4320;
```

vb.net

```
'--- Get Width  
Dim width As Integer = oAbsolutePositioning.Width  
  
'--- Set Width to 3 inches  
oAbsolutePositioning.Width = 4320
```
