

# Worksheet.SavePdf(String)

Introduced in build 10.0

## Description

Saves a [Worksheet](#) as a PDF file at a specified file path.

**C#**

```
public static void SavePdf(String filePath)
```

**vb.net**

```
Public Static Sub SavePdf(ByVal filePath As String)
```

## Parameters

***filePath***

A `string` representing the filepath you would like to save the PDF to.

## Exceptions

***System.Exception***

If there is a problem creating, opening, or writing to the file specified, or reading from the `Worksheet` object.

## Remarks

The [Worksheet.PageSetup](#) property will be used to specify how the worksheet should be rendered to the PDF document. The individual `PageSetup` options are reflected in the final document.

## Examples

**C#**

```
ExcelApplication xla = new ExcelApplication();  
    Workbook WB= xla.Create(FileFormat.Xlsx);  
    Worksheet worksheet= WB[0];  
    worksheet.SavePdf("Path/filename.pdf");
```

## vb.net

```
Dim oExcelApp As New ExcelApplication()  
    Dim WB As Workbook = oExcelApp.Create(FileFormat.Xlsx)  
    Dim worksheet As Worksheet= WB[0]  
    worksheet.SavePdf("Path/filename.pdf")
```
