

ExcelTemplate.RemoveExtraDataMarkers

Description

Sets whether ExcelWriter should remove data markers in the template that do not bind to data sources in code.

C#

```
public boolean RemoveExtraDataMarkers{ get; set; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Property RemoveExtraDataMarkers() As Boolean
```

Remarks

By default, if a data marker does not bind to a data source, ExcelWriter will throw an exception. If `RemoveExtraDataMarkers` is set to `true`, ExcelWriter will remove extra data markers silently.

If a data marker includes the "Optional" modifier, and does not bind to a data source, ExcelWriter will remove it without error even if `RemoveExtraDataMarkers` is set to `false`.

`RemoveExtraDataMarkers` is a **Read/Write** property.

Examples

```

vb.net

```

```
