

# PageSetup.GetHeader(HeaderFooterSection.Section)

Introduced in build 4.5.1

## Description

Returns a section of the header.

### C#

```
public HeaderFooterSection GetHeader(HeaderFooterSection.Section section)
```

### vb.net

```
Public Function GetHeader(ByVal section As HeaderFooterSection.Section) As  
HeaderFooterSection
```

## Parameters

### *section*

The section of the header to return

## Returns

A [HeaderFooterSection](#) object representing the specified section of the header

## Examples

### C#

```
//--- Get the right header of the first worksheet  
    HeaderFooterSection myLeftFooter =  
WB[0].PageSetup.GetHeader(HeaderFooterSection.Section.Right);
```

### vb.net

```
'--- Get the right header of the first worksheet  
    Dim myLeftFooter As HeaderFooterSection =  
WB[0].PageSetup.GetHeader(HeaderFooterSection.Section.Right)
```

## Remarks

You can use a [HeaderFooterSection](#) object to manipulate a given section of the header or footer, such as the text or image that appears in that section. Note that the total length of the text in all sections of the header may not exceed 255 characters.
