HourMinute12	h:mm AM/PM;@ (For example, 12:00 AM.)
HourMinute24	h:mm;@ (For example, 0:00.)
HourMinuteSecond12	h:mm:ss AM/PM;@ (For example, 12:00:00 AM.)
HourMinuteSecond24	h:mm:ss;@ (For example, 0:00:00.)
MinuteSecondTenths	mm:ss.0;@ (For example, 00:00.0.)
