

# PivotTables

Introduced in build 8.4

## Description

The `PivotTables` collection represents the set of `PivotTables` in a worksheet. To return a `PivotTables` collection, use `Worksheet.PivotTables`.

### C#

```
[DefaultMember("Item")]  
public sealed class PivotTables: System.Collections.Generic.IEnumerable<PivotTables>
```

### vb.net

```
<DefaultMember("Item")> _  
Public NotInheritable Class PivotTables  
    Implements System.Collections.Generic.IEnumerable(Of PivotTable)
```

## Properties

Name	Description
<a href="#">Count</a>	Returns the number of <code>PivotTables</code> in the worksheet.

## Indexers

Name	Description
<a href="#">Item(Int32)</a>	Returns the <code>PivotTable</code> at the specified 0-based position in the <code>PivotTables</code> collection.
<a href="#">Item(String)</a>	Returns the <code>PivotTable</code> with the specified name in the <code>PivotTables</code> collection.

## Methods

Name	Description
<a href="#">CreatePivotTable(Area, Int32, Int32)</a>	Creates a new, blank <code>PivotTable</code> for the specified area. A <code>PivotTable</code> created by this method is part of <code>PivotTables</code> collection.
<a href="#">CreateConsolidatedPivotTable(IEnumerable, Int32, Int32)</a>	Creates a new <code>PivotTable</code> for multiple consolidated ranges. A <code>PivotTable</code> created by this method is part of <code>PivotTables</code> collection.
<a href="#">GetEnumerator()</a>	Returns an <code>IEnumerator</code> for the <code>PivotTables</code> in a <code>Worksheet</code> .
