

# Condition.ComparisonType

## Description

Returns the [Condition's Condition.Comparison](#) value, which determines whether each cell value will be compared with one or two other values, or if a formula will be evaluated for each cell.

### C#

```
public Comparison ComparisonType{ get; }
```

### vb.net

```
Public ReadOnly Property ComparisonType() As Comparison
```

## Examples

### C#

```
ExcelApplication xla = new ExcelApplication();  
Workbook wb = xla.Create();  
ConditionalFormat condFmt = wb.CreateConditionalFormat();  
Condition cond =  
    condFmt.CreateCondition(  
        Condition.Comparison.CellValueGreaterThan,  
        "=100");  
Condition.Comparison compType = cond.ComparisonType;
```

### vb.net

```
Dim xla As New ExcelApplication()  
Dim wb As Workbook = xla.Create()  
Dim condFmt As ConditionalFormat = wb.CreateConditionalFormat()  
Dim cond As Condition = _  
    condFmt.CreateCondition( _  
        Condition.Comparison.CellValueGreaterThan, _  
        "=100")  
Dim compType As Condition.Comparison = cond.ComparisonType
```
