

PivotTableSettings.ValuesLabelOnRow

Description

Sets or returns whether the values labels field should be placed as a Row Label or Column Label

C#

```
public boolean CalculatedFieldsOnRow{ get; set; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Property CalculatedFieldsOnRow() As Boolean
```

Examples

C#

```
ExcelApplication xla = new ExcelApplication();  
Workbook wb = xla.Open(@"C:\MySpreadsheet.xlsx");  
Worksheet ws = wb.Worksheets[0];  
ws.PivotTables[0].PivotTableSettings.ValuesLabelOnRow = true;
```

vb.net

```
Dim xla As New ExcelApplication()  
Dim wb As Workbook = xla.Open("C:\MySpreadsheet.xlsx")  
Dim ws As Worksheet = wb.Worksheets(0)  
ws.PivotTables(0).PivotTableSettings.ValuesLabelOnRow = true;
```

Remarks

ValuesLabelOnRow is `false` by default.

When creating a pivot table, set this option before adding any fields to ensure the values label field is created where it is intended. If this option is changed on a pivot table that already has a values label field, that field will be moved to the new position.
