The *Project Proposal* contains information about a new software project, including team members and expected costs. This sample consists of three parts that demonstrate the basics of designing a presentation with PowerPointWriter. By the end of this sample you will be able to create a presentation that takes advantage of the features of both PowerPointTemplate and PowerPointApplication.

This sample focuses on importing basic text, including multiple rows of data, and using RepeatSlide behavior.
