## Description

The [PivotTables](#) collection represents the set of PivotTables in a worksheet. To return a PivotTables collection, use [PivotTables](#).

### C#

[DefaultMember("Item")]  
public sealed class PivotTables: System.Collections.Generic.IEnumerable<PivotTables>
```

### vb.net

```
<DefaultMember("Item")> _  
Public NotInheritable Class PivotTables  
    Implements System.Collections.Generic.IEnumerable(Of PivotTable)
```

## Properties

Name	Description
<a href="#">Count</a>	Returns the number of PivotTables in the worksheet.

## Indexers

Name	Description
<a href="#">Item(Int32)</a>	Returns the <a href="#">PivotTable</a> at the specified 0-based position in the <a href="#">PivotTables</a> collection.
<a href="#">Item(String)</a>	Returns the <a href="#">PivotTable</a> with the specified name in the <a href="#">PivotTables</a> collection.

## Methods

Name	Description
<a href="#">CreatePivotTable(Area, Int32, Int32)</a>	Creates a new, blank PivotTable for the specified area. A PivotTable created by this method is part of <a href="#">PivotTables</a> collection.
<a href="#">CreateConsolidatedPivotTable(IEnumerable, Int32, Int32)</a>	Creates a new PivotTable for multiple consolidated ranges. A PivotTable created by this method is part of <a href="#">PivotTables</a> collection.
<a href="#">GetEnumerator()</a>	Returns an IEnumerator for the PivotTables in a Worksheet.
