

PivotTableSettings.ShowFriendlyErrorCaption

Introduced in build 8.4

Description

Sets or returns whether Microsoft Excel will automatically show a caption in place of an error.

C#

```
public boolean ShowFriendlyErrorCaption{ get; set; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Property ShowFriendlyErrorCaption() As Boolean
```

Examples

C#

```
ExcelApplication xla = new ExcelApplication();  
Workbook wb = xla.Open(@"C:\MySpreadsheet.xlsx");  
Worksheet ws = wb.Worksheets[0];  
ws.PivotTables[0].PivotTableSettings.ShowFriendlyErrorCaption= true;
```

vb.net

```
Dim xla As New ExcelApplication()  
Dim wb As Workbook = xla.Open("C:\MySpreadsheet.xlsx")  
Dim ws As Worksheet = wb.Worksheets(0)  
ws.PivotTables(0).PivotTableSettings.ShowFriendlyErrorCaption= true;
```

Remarks

ShowFriendlyErrorCaption is false by default. If it is set to true, [FriendlyErrorCaption](#) also needs to be set.
