

DataBindingProperties.MaxRows

Description

Sets or returns the maximum number of rows to be bound to the template file when the [ExcelTemplate.BindData](#) or [ExcelTemplate.BindColumnData](#) methods are called.

C#

```
public int MaxRows{ get; set; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Property MaxRows() As Integer
```

Remarks

Any rows in the data source after the [MaxRows](#) value will not be added to the template.

MaxRows is a **Read/Write** property.

Examples

C#

```
DataBaseindingProperties dbp = xlt.CreateDataBaseindingProperties();  
dbp.MaxRows = 20;  
xlt.BindData(twodim, names, "TwoDimArray", dbp);  
xlt.Save(Page.Response, "output.xls", false);
```

vb.net

```
Dim dbp As DataBaseindingProperties = xlt.CreateDataBaseindingProperties()  
dbp.MaxRows = 20  
xlt.BindData(twodim, names, "TwoDimArray", dbp)  
xlt.Save(Page.Response, "output.xls", False)
```
