

Font.ScriptStyle

Description

Sets or returns the vertical position of the font in relation to other text.

C#

```
public VerticalPosition ScriptStyle{ get; set; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Property ScriptStyle() As VerticalPosition
```

Remarks

If the vertical position is [Superscript](#), the font will be slightly higher than other text. If the vertical position is [Subscript](#), the font will be slightly lower than other text. If the vertical position is set to [None](#), the font will be displayed normally.

Examples

C#

```
//--- Get ScriptStyle
Font.VerticalPosition scrStyle = fnt.ScripstStyle;

//--- Set ScriptStyle
fnt.ScriptStyle = Font.VerticalPosition.Subscript;
```

vb.net

```
'--- Get ScriptStyle
Dim scrStyle As Font.VerticalPosition = fnt.ScriptStyle

'--- Set ScriptStyle
fnt.ScriptStyle = Font.VerticalPosition.Subscript
```
