

# AbsolutePositioning.OriginX

## Description

Returns the horizontal origin of the position's [AbsolutePositioning.X](#). Possible values are: Column, Margin, Page.

### C#

```
<p> public HorizontalOrigin OriginX{ get; set; }</p>
```

### vb.net

```
<p>Public Property OriginX() As HorizontalOrigin</p>
```

### C#

```
//--- Get HorizontalOrigin  
    AbsolutePositioning.HorizontalOrigin oHorizontalOrigin =  
oAbsolutePositioning.OriginX;  
  
    //--- Set HorizontalOrigin  
    oAbsolutePositioning.OriginX = AbsolutePositioning.HorizontalOrigin.Margin;
```

### vb.net

```
'--- Get HorizontalOrigin  
    Dim oHorizontalOrigin As AbsolutePositioning.HorizontalOrigin =  
oAbsolutePositioning.OriginX  
  
    '--- Set HorizontalOrigin  
    oAbsolutePositioning.OriginX= AbsolutePositioning.HorizontalOrigin.Margin
```
