

Workbook.GetNamedRange(String)

Description

Returns the specified named [Range](#). If the named range does not exist, the method returns null.

C#

```
public Range GetNamedRange(System.String name)
```

vb.net

```
Public Function GetNamedRange(ByVal name As String) As Range
```

Parameters

name

The name of the range.

Returns

A named Range object, or null if the range does not exist.

Examples

C#

```
Range rng = wb.GetNamedRange("Range1");
```

vb.net

```
Dim rng As Range = wb.GetNamedRange("Range1")
```
