

Cells.Item(Int32, Int32)

Description

Represents a single cell in a [Cells](#) collection. [Item](#) is the indexer of the `Cells` collection, so `Cells[0, 0]` is equivalent to `Cells.Item(0, 0)`.

C#

```
public Cell this[int rowNumber, int columnNumber] { get; }
```

vb.net

```
Public Default ReadOnly Property Item(ByVal rowNumber As Integer, ByVal columnNumber  
As Integer) As Cell
```

Parameters

rowNumber

The 0-based row number of the cell to retrieve.

columnNumber

The 0-based column number of the cell to retrieve.

Returns

A [Cell](#) object representing the cell at the specified position.

Examples

C#

```
Cell cellA1 = cls[0, 0];
```

vb.net

```
Dim cellA1 As Cell = cls(0, 0)
```
