

WordTemplate.Save(String)

Description

Saves the generated Word file on the server.

C#

```
public void Save(System.String outputFileName)
```

vb.net

```
Public Sub Save(ByVal outputFileName As String)
```

Parameters

strFilePath

Specifies a complete path and file name for the generated file. WordWriter will save the file to this location. If a file with the same name exists, it will be overwritten by the new Word file.

Exceptions

ArgumentNullException

Save will throw this exception if `null` (C#) or `Nothing` (VB.NET) is passed to the method.

Remarks

You can call [Save](#) more than once for a single instance of [WordTemplate](#). This allows you to save more than one copy of a generated file and/or save the file on the server and stream it to the client.

Examples

C#

```
WordTemplate oWW = new WordTemplate();  
oWW.Open(@"c:\templates\Template.doc");  
oWW.SetDataSource(arrValue, arrName);  
oWW.Process();  
oWW.Save(@"c:\reports\Report.doc");
```

vb.net

```
Dim oWW As New WordTemplate()  
oWW.Open("c:\templates\Template.doc")  
oWW.SetDataSource(arrValue, arrName)  
oWW.Process()  
oWW.Save("c:\reports\Report.doc")
```
